RTF Consideration #5:

Increase number of coaches permissible to recruit off-campus at one time from two to three.

Rationale In Support of RTF #5:

- Consideration would make it possible for programs to attend more national qualifying tournaments that are scheduled on the same weekends
- Consideration may have a positive effect on coaches' quality of life as it creates a more flexible environment for coaches to be off-campus recruiting.
- Consideration would encourage the overall growth of the sport of women's volleyball by creating more coaching opportunities.
- Given the fact that quiet periods and the 80-day limitation, the opportunity to have three coaches recruiting off-campus at one time would allow everyone to do more work.
- Consideration does not increase the number of days a program is allowed to recruit off-campus (remains at 80 days).

Rationale Opposed to RTF #5:

- Consideration does not take into concern that many programs only have two full-time coaches and there is no guarantee that programs will be automatically provided an additional coaching staff member.
- There is a perceived increase in expenses should this consideration be forwarded.
- Consideration does not take into concern that there is a strong sentiment around the country that one coach should be on-campus at all times.
