2009 AVCA Annual Convention – Tampa, Florida
December 16 – 20, 2009

Thanks to a grant provided by the NCAA, the American Volleyball Coaches Association will host its seventh professional coaching workshop for minority women December 16 – 20 in conjunction with the 2009 AVCA Annual Convention. The workshop will provide an opportunity for attendees to interact with others who have had success at all levels of coaching. It will also allow attendees to explore the limitless networking and educational opportunities available at the AVCA Annual Convention. This is a unique opportunity to develop your professional skills and become a better coach and leader.

Per NCAA Grant requirements, eligible attendees must be minority women intent on pursuing volleyball coaching at an NCAA institution as a head or assistant coach. Workshop attendees do not need to currently hold such a position, but must aspire to enter the NCAA collegiate coaching field. **Previous workshop attendees are welcome to attend but are not eligible for a scholarship.** Prime candidates for this program are college seniors, high school and club coaches looking for college jobs, DII, DIII, NAIA and junior college assistants willing to move to head coaching positions, and DI second assistant and graduate assistants. Minority men are a secondary target for this program.

Returning attendees who would like to participate in the workshop activities should first register for the convention through the regular online or printed registration process. Participants should then complete the printed workshop registration form below and return to the AVCA by **November 30th**. Completing this form will help the AVCA compile accurate numbers for planning session seating.
