

SOUTH DAKOTA TO HOST 2010 NATIONAL COACHES CONVENTION IN JUNE!

The 2010 National High School Athletic Coaches Association Annual Meeting will be held in Sioux Falls, S.D. June 19-23, 2010. Cost of the convention is only \$100!

The best coaches from across the country will present eight volleyball-specific sessions in addition to sessions pertaining to all athletic coaches. Dr. Tom Osborne will speak at the FREE FCA luncheon, FREE coffee and rolls will be provided in the morning, and a FREE Whopper Feed will be held on South Dakota Night. A silent auction, golf outings, and tours are also available in addition to two workshops held prior to the main convention.

The first workshop, "Health, Behavior, and Legal Challenges in High School Sports: Who is at Risk?" will be held June 19-20, 2010. The emphasis of this workshop is to focus on many health and behavior issues faced not only by coaches, but issues that many classroom teachers at all levels also face--diabetes, obesity, asthma, and performance-enhancing substances. Sanford Health will be providing experts in these areas throughout the day on Saturday. Saturday evening and Sunday will focus on "The Seven Traits of a Champion, legal issues to include risk management and legal duties, bullying behavior and other inappropriate behavior, and racial issues.
