MaxPreps/AVCA HIGH SCHOOL PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Ohio

Kelly Lehrer – Huron

Junior, Setter, 5-8 – Huron, Ohio

Kelly Lehrer, a junior setter from Huron High School in Huron, Ohio, has been named the MaxPreps/AVCA Ohio High School volleyball Player of the Week. Lehrer earns the award after quarterbacking Huron to a perfect 18-0 record to begin the season. Through seven games played last week, the 5'8" sparkplug racked up 74 assists, for a 10.57 assists per game average, with her team also sporting a hitting percentage of .406 through that span. Lehrer also tallied two aces, two blocks and six kills during the frame, in addition to pulling up 24 digs, for a 3.42 digs per game average. Huron is coached by Don Wood.

Michigan

Laura Heinz - Clinton

Senior, Middle blocker, 6-1 – Clinton, Mich.

Laura Heinz, a senior middle blocker from Clinton High School in Clinton, Mich., has been named the MaxPreps/AVCA Michigan High School volleyball Player of the Week. Coldren picked up the honor after helping her Redskins squad to a 24-4 record to date, including victories in seven of their last nine outings. Through four games played last week, the 6'1" power in the middle smacked 16 kills, for a 4.00 kills per game average. The senior leader's defensive skills also helped shut down her opponents, as she recorded six blocks during the span. In addition Heinz tallied three digs, one service ace and one assist for the Redskins. Clinton is coached by Patty Vandeventer.

California

Christina Bauch – El Toro

Sophomore, Outside hitter, 5-10 – Lake Forest, Calif.

Christina Bauch, a sophomore outside hitter for El Toro High School in Lake Forest, Calif., has been named the MaxPreps/AVCA California High School volleyball Player of the Week. She earned the award for her contributions in leading the Charges to a 10-7 record thus far in the season. Through her last five games played, the 5'10" attacking machine pounded 21 kills, to average 5.250 kills per game. In addition, Bauch put forth a strong defensive effort, registering 24 digs, for a 6.00 digs per game average. Bauch also tallied two service aces and an assist during the span. Lake Forest is coached by Brian David.
