MaxPreps/AVCA HIGH SCHOOL PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Ohio

***Jojo Krieg - Lima Central Catholic
Junior, Outside Hitter - Lima, Ohio***

Jojo Krieg, a junior outside hitter for Lima Central Catholic High School in Lima, Ohio, has been named the MaxPreps/AVCA Ohio High School volleyball Player of the Week. She earned the award while helping the Thunderbirds to a 27-2 record to date, and victories in their last seven matches in a row. Through eight games last week, Krieg had 35 kills for an average of 4.4 kills per game. She also added 22 digs (2.75 dpg) and two blocks in the matches as well. Lima Central Catholic is coached by Dave Franklin.

Michigan

***Danielle Gotham - South Lyon
South Lyon, Mich.***

Danielle Gotham a junior from South Lyon High School in South Lyon, Mich., has been named the MaxPreps/AVCA Michigan High School volleyball Player of the Week. Gotham earned the honor by helping the Lions to wins in five of its last six matches and a 10-9 season record to date. In four games last week, she put away 30 kills for a 7.5 kills per game average. The Lions are coached by Jennifer Mainka.

California

***Bree Rauschenbach - California Lutheran
Senior, 6-0 - Wildomar, Calif.***

Bree Rauschenbach, a senior from California Lutheran High School in Wildomar, Calif., has been named the MaxPreps/AVCA California High School volleyball Player of the Week. She earned the honor for helping lead the C-Hawks to a 24-4 overall record to date, including the team's current five-game win streak. In 12 games last week, Rauschenbach smacked down 82 kills at a 6.83 kills per game average. She also chipped in 53 digs (4.42 dpg), 22 blocks and 10 aces in those games as well. The C-Hawks are coached by Dani Raiser.

Arizona

***Ashley Kastl - Mountain Pointe
Junior, Outside Hitter - Phoenix, Ariz.***

Ashley Kastl, a junior outside hitter for Mountain Pointe High School in Phoenix, Ariz., has been named the MaxPreps/AVCA Arizona High School volleyball Player of the Week. She earned the award for her strong play in leading the Pride to its current 37-9 overall record and wins in 10 of the team's last 11 matches. In 10 games last week, Kastl scored 41 kills for a 4.1 kills per game average. She also played strong on defense as well, picking up 50 digs (5.0 dpg), while also adding nine aces and one block. Mountain Pointe is coached by Fred Mann.

Colorado

Jessica Giltner - Holy Family

Senior, 6-0 - Broomfield, Colo.

Jessica Giltner, a senior for Holy Family High School in Broomfield, Colo., has been named the MaxPreps/AVCA Colorado High School volleyball Player of the Week. She earned the distinction for her efforts in guiding the Tigers to a 26-4 record so far this season. In Holy Family's 14 games last week, Giltner was solid on both offense and defense. Offensively, she collected 40 kills for a 2.86 kills per game average. Defensively, the 6-0 athlete had 14 digs (1.0 dpg) and 17 blocks. The Tigers are coached by Trisha Kroll.

Florida

Lindsay Young - Berkeley Prep

Sophomore, Middle Hitter/Outside Hitter, 6-0 - Tampa, Fla.

Lindsay Young, a sophomore middle hitter/outside hitter for Berkeley Prep in Tampa, Fla., has been named the MaxPreps/AVCA Florida High School volleyball Player of the Week. She earned the award for her strong play this year in leading the Buccaneers to a 24-6 overall record to date. In addition to Berkeley Prep's current 10-game win streak, Young has helped guide the team to wins in 16 of its last 17 matches. In her six games last week, Young scored 25 kills for a 4.17 kills per game average. She also added 18 digs (3.0 dpg) and 11 blocks in those games for her team. Berkeley Prep is coached by Randy Dagostino.

Minnesota

Megan Carlson - Andover

Senior, 5-10 - Andover, Minn.

Megan Carlson, a senior for Andover High School in Andover, Minn., has been named the MaxPreps/AVCA Minnesota High School volleyball Player of the Week. The 5-10 athlete receives the award for leading her team to its current 27-5 record. In the Huskies 10 games last week, Carlson averaged 4.5 kills per game after pounding down 45 kills. On defense, she picked up 56 digs (5.6 dpg) and two blocks, while also chipping in six aces. The Huskies are coached by Connie Huberty.

New York

Brynn Lettieri - Westhampton Beach

Westhampton Beach, N.Y.

Brynn Lettieri of Westhampton Beach High School in Westhampton Beach, N.Y., has been named the MaxPreps/AVCA New York High School volleyball Player of the Week. She earned the award for her key play in leading the Hurricanes to a 19-2 record to date, including its current eight-game win streak. In five games last week, Lettieri had 23 kills for a 4.6 kills per game average. Westhampton Beach is coached by Lenny Zaloga.
