## **MaxPreps/AVCA HIGH SCHOOL PLAYERS OF THE WEEK**

### **California**

***Kirsten Duren – Ripon***

***Junior, Outside hitter/Setter, 5-4 – Ripon, Calif.***

Kirsten Duren, a junior outside hitter/setter for Ripon High School in Ripon, Calif., has been named the MaxPreps/AVCA California High School volleyball Player of the Week. She earned the award for her strong play in leading Ripon to an 11-4 record thus far in the season, including rattling off six consecutive victories. Through her last five games, Duren has smacked 30 kills, to average 6.0 kills per game during that span. In addition, Duren co-commanded the Ripon attack, dishing out 30 assists for a 6.0 assists per game ratio. Duren also averaged 4.4 digs for the week, while totaling six service aces and four blocks. Ripon is coached by Larry Keethe.

### **Ohio**

***Katelyn Jinks – Unioto***

***Junior, Middle Blocker, 5-10 – Chillicothe, Ohio***

Katelyn Jinks, a junior middle blocker for Unioto High School in Chillicothe, Ohio, has been named the MaxPreps/AVCA Ohio High School volleyball Player of the Week. She earned the award after playing an integral part in Unioto's 16-2 record to start the season, including winning 12 of its last 13 contests. Through four games last week, Jinks swatted 18 kills, for an average of 4.5 kills per game. She also added four blocks, two assists and eight digs as a part of Unioto's front line offensive arsenal. Jinks is coached by Aaron Ridenour.

### **Michigan**

***Molly Coldren – Notre Dame Prep***

***Senior, Outside hitter/Middle blocker, 5-9 – West Bloomfield, Mich.***

Molly Coldren, a senior outside hitter/middle blocker from Notre Dame Prep High School in Pontiac, Mich., has been named the MaxPreps/AVCA Michigan High School volleyball Player of the Week. Coldren picked up the honor after helping her Fighting Irish squad to a 31-3 record to date, running off an impressive 15 wins in their last 16 outings. Through her five games last week, Coldren smashed 31 kills, for a 6.2 average per game. She also racked up four blocks, six assists and five digs during the span, as one of Notre Dame's top offensive threats. In addition, on September 28, she was named a finalist for Michigan's Miss Volleyball and was named player of the week for the *Detroit Free Press* on September 21. Coldren is coached by Betty Wroubel.
