

2021-2025 AVCA Volleyball Officials Appreciation Week | #OFFICIATIONWEEK

Since 2021, AVCA #OFFICIATIONWEEK has become a proud annual tradition among nearly 2,000 elementary school, middle school, high school (boys and girls), club, beach, college men's and women's, and pro volleyball teams from 49 U.S. states, D.C. and other nations. The event is hosted twice each year, in the spring and fall; and all teams are encouraged to participate. The [AVCA's Annual Spring #OFFICIATIONWEEK](#) is especially for boys, men's, beach, club and pro teams, and [AVCA Fall #OFFICIATIONWEEK2025](#) is primarily for girls and women's teams.

Instructions to Participate: 5 Steps

1. Choose a match during #OFFICIATIONWEEK2025
2. Plan a small token of appreciation for officials pre-match – include both teams
3. Snap a group photo with officials, both teams and coaches
4. Post to social media tagging #OFFICIATIONWEEK2025 and @avcavolleyball
5. [Submit your event](#) to the AVCA to be added to our [National Participants List](#)

The events are hosted by the AVCA High School Leadership Council. While the athletes, coaches and teams plan and lead the individual official's appreciation events, the national campaign's success is also credited to AVCA's Affiliate Program Partners; high school athletic associations; intercollegiate athletic conferences; public and private high schools and universities; and USA Volleyball Regions who encouraged their teams to participate.

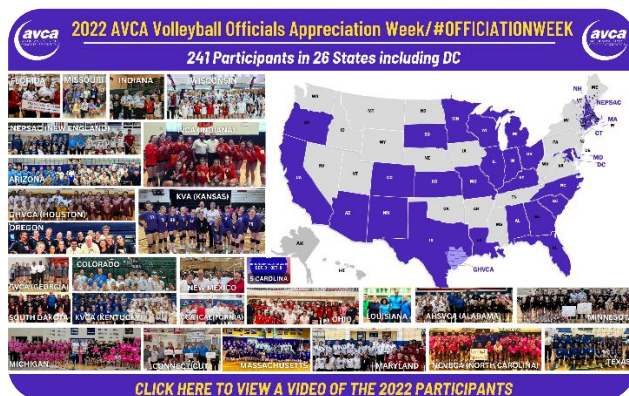
2021 AVCA Volleyball Officials Appreciation Week

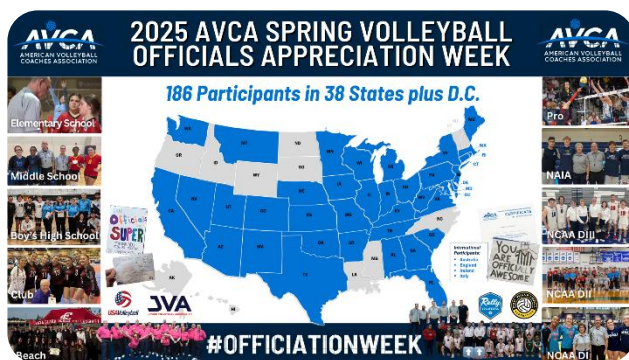
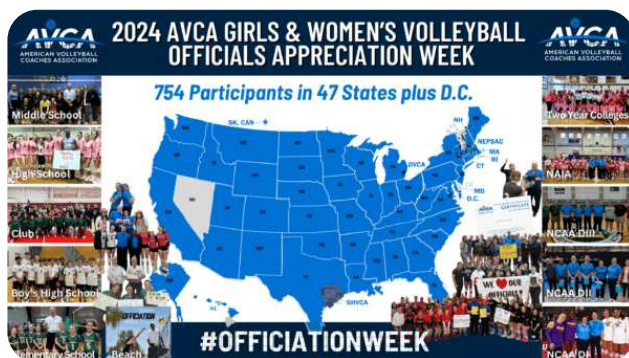

[2025 AVCA Spring Volleyball Officials Appreciation Week: 186 Participants in 38 States plus D.C.](#)

The AVCA's 3rd Annual Spring Volleyball Officials Appreciation Week March 21-29, 2025, saw enthusiastic participation from across the country. 186 teams and programs from 38 states and D.C. took part in this nationwide initiative to honor volleyball officials. This year marked the first official Pro Volleyball #OFFICIATIONWEEK, expanding the celebration to include boys, men's, beach, club, and professional volleyball.

The effort was strengthened by the involvement of leading volleyball organizations such as the Junior Volleyball Association (JVA), USA Volleyball, the Pro Volleyball Federation, and numerous state and local volleyball coaches associations. Over the nine-day period, coaches led the charge in promoting respect and gratitude toward officials, setting a positive example for athletes, parents, and fans, and reinforcing the essential role officials play in the sport's growth and integrity.
