

### **Thursday, April 17**

Teams have been divided into six pools of three teams based on seasonal results through Sunday, April 13. All teams will have two pool play matches on Thursday. On Friday all teams will be placed in Challenge Round play based on pool results. The first and second place teams in each pool will compete in Challenge 1, 2, or 3. The third place team in each pool will play in Challenge 4 or 5. All teams will have two Challenge Round matches on Friday. Challenges 1, 2 and 3 will be modified pool play. The (6) teams that win the first Challenge Round match will advance to the Gold Bracket. The (6) teams that lose the first Challenge Round match will advance to the Silver Bracket. Byes in the Gold and Silver Bracket will be determined based on the bracket bye procedures referenced below. The first place team in Challenges 4 and 5 will receive a bye in the Bronze Bracket. The second and third place teams in Challenge 4 and 5 will advance to the Bronze quarterfinals.

Championship bracket play will begin on Saturday. Please note that in order to finish early enough for teams to travel home on Saturday afternoon there are no consolation matches scheduled. When a team loses on Saturday that will be the last match for the team. All teams will play a minimum of one match and up to three matches on Saturday depending on the results. The Division II Champion will be the winner of the Gold bracket.

The following procedures will be followed when determining pool play standings:

1. Overall win/loss record in pool play

2. Head-to-head competition between tied teams. If 3 teams are tied and all split head-to-head competitions the tiebreaker will move to procedure #3.
3. Set win/loss percentage among tied teams (total sets won/total sets played)
4. Point differential percentage (total points won/total points played)
5. Coin flip

#### **Gold/Silver Bracket Bye Determination Procedures**

The following procedures will be followed when determining the two byes in the Gold and Silver Brackets:

1. Overall team record in both pool and challenge play
2. Pairs win/loss percentage in both pool and challenge play
3. Set win/loss percentage in both pool and challenge round play (total sets won/total sets played)
4. Point differential percentage (total points won/total points played)
5. Higher seeded team

Bye determination example:

1. School is 4-0 at conclusion of day 2 challenge round matches – win percentage is 100%
2. Match 1 score: 3-0; Match 2 score: 3-1; Match 3 score: 3-0; Match 4 score: 3-2  
Total pair record 12-3; Pairs win/loss percentage is 80%
3. Match 1 set record: 6-1; Match 2 set record: 7-3; Match 3 set record: 6-0; Match 4 record: 8-6  
Set win/loss record 27-10; Set win/loss percentage is 73%
