




2025 AVCA HIGH SCHOOL AWARDS OVERVIEW



AVCA High School All-America

Total number of All-America Selections:

AVCA High School All-America timeline:

- Friday, October 10th Online nominations for AVCA High School All-America & AVCA Best and Brightest open at 8:00 am (ET)
- Monday, October 20th Online nominations for AVCA High School All-America close + High School Coach of the Year nomination forms due to AVCA Office at 5:00 pm (ET)
- Wednesday, October 29th Best & Brightest Lists Announced
- Wednesday, November 5th- All-Region Teams & Region Players of the Year Announced
- Tuesday, November 18th Girls' High School All-America Teams announced
- Wednesday, November 19th Region Coaches of the Year announced
- Wednesday, November 26th National Coach of the Year announced

Regional & National Award Overview

- Region Player of the Year: One (1) selection made per Region
- National Player of the Year: One (1) selection made nationally, to be announced at the AVCA All-America Banquet in Kansas City, MO
- National Player of the Year Finalists: Four (4) finalists selected and invited to attend the AVCA All-America Banquet in Kansas City, MO

- Region Coaches of the Year: Four (4) selections made per Region. Coaches must be AVCA members in order to be eligible.
- National Coach of the Year: One (1)
 selection made nationally, to be
 awarded at the AVCA Coach of the Year
 Banquet in Kansas City, MO. Coaches
 must be AVCA members and nominated
 via the AVCA nomination form.

AVCA High School All-America - Nomination FAQs

- There is no cap or limit to the number of nominees from each school.
- High School Head Coaches must have an active AVCA HS membership in order to submit a nomination. If you have a club membership, contact the AVCA to have it switched to your high school for the duration of the nomination period.
- Freshmen, Sophomores. Juniors, and Seniors in high school are eligible for nomination. Middle school athletes are not eligible for consideration, even if they compete on their high school varsity teams (per individual state regulations).
- Athletes on the Watch List are not automatically considered for the All-America teams. A nomination must be received during the October 10-20 timeframe.
- Nominating coaches will be asked to rank the nominated athletes from their school during the question, "Please rank the athlete that you are currently nominating." If there is only one nominee from that school, please assign them as #1. If there are multiple nominations from one school, please rank the players accordingly from highest or most qualified nominee onwards. This is done in order to assist the region committees during All-Region and All-America selections and can be expanded upon in the Significant Awards section if needed.

AVCA High School All-America - Stats Submission FAQs

- Stats must be entered on either the AVCA nomination form or MaxPreps website. You do not need to do both. We will merge records if stats are submitted via both portals and take the most up-to-date version of the submitted stats (i.e. if you submit your stats on the AVCA portal on 10/10 but also submit on MaxPreps, the MaxPreps stats will be updated and sent to us after nominations close on 10/20, so those would be the stats used during committee evaluation.)
- The AVCA nomination portal will require that you still enter the team Games Played and Sets Played on the AVCA stats submission page, even if you are planning to submit stats via MaxPreps. If you plan to submit stats on MaxPreps, please enter the team games played and sets played on the AVCA stats submission page then click "Submit". The portal will require those two sections to be completed in order to ensure the 50% sets played eligibility requirement is met, but stats do NOT have to be submitted on that same page if you are submitting them on MaxPreps.
- If an AVCA nomination form is received with no stats on the second page, and no stats are later submitted via MaxPreps, the nomination will be considered incomplete.
- If MaxPreps stats are submitted and an AVCA nomination form is not submitted, the nomination will be considered incomplete.




Incomplete nominations will not be evaluated for the AVCA awards.

Step 3: Click "Enter New Nomination" to begin a new nomination.







Step 6: If you are entering your complete stats on the AVCA portal, enter the complete stats for your player then click "Complete Nomination" to submit the nomination.

If you are submitting your stats on MaxPreps, the only required sections on this page are:
Team GP and GP (Team Games Played and Individual Games Played, see arrow for location). If you plan to submit on MaxPreps, only enter the Team GP and GP and press "Complete Nomination" in order to submit the nomination.

Helpful tip: games played is also referred to as sets played.




Step 7: View your completed nomination on the home page. Please note that if your nomination says "No" under "Complete" it is not submitted yet. Repeat as needed for any additional athletes on your team.

AVCA Best and Brightest Award

- Honors individual High School Senior athletes who excel on and off the court
- Nomination is completed via a Best and Brightest nomination form on the AVCA Awards portal
- Coaches must have consent from the athlete to share their GPA via the nomination form.

Senior athletes must earn at least a 3.5 Unweighted GPA on a 4.0 scale (or the equivalent, if using a weighted or different GPA scale) during their Junior year AND play in 50% of their Varsity team's sets during their Senior season in order to be eligible for the Best and Brightest Award.

Three additional tiers of recognition apply:


- AVCA Best and Brightest First Team: 3.8
 Unweighted GPA or above
- AVCA Best and Brightest Second Team: 3.65
 Unweighted GPA or above
- AVCA Best and Brightest Honorable Mention:
 3.5 Unweighted GPA or above



AVCA Award Best and Brightest | Student Athlete Info AVCA Best and Brightest Award

The AVCA Best and Brightest Award will honor individual Senior athletes who excel on the court and in the classroom. In order to be eligible, Senior athletes must earn at least a 3.5 Unweighted/4.0 Weighted GPA (or the equivalent, if using a different GPA scale) during their Junior year AND play in 50% of their Varsity team's sets during their Senior season to qualify for the award. If your school uses a grading scale other than those available for selection below, please contact Sarah Black at sarah.black@avca.org.

Additionally, the AVCA will offer tiers of the awarded athletes in these categories:

- AVCA Best and Brightest First Team: 3.8 Unweighted GPA/4.3 Weighted GPA or above
- AVCA Best and Brightest Second Team: 3.65 Unweighted GPA/4.15 Weighted GPA or above
- AVCA Best and Brightest Third Team: 3.5 Unweighted GPA/4.0 Weighted GPA or above
