2025 Nationally and Regionally Ranked Teams

AVCA will publish its list of Nationally and Regionally Ranked Teams on **Wednesday, November 5**. List will also be emailed to all AVCA member head coaches. **ONLY teams on this list are to be considered when compiling summary statistics for regionally and nationally ranked competition in the postseason awards process.**

A match against a Nationally- and/or Regionally-Ranked Team must be included regardless of whether or not that team was ranked at the time of competition.

If your team has NOT competed against any Nationally Ranked (or Regionally Ranked) teams, you must enter the following on the stats page of your nomination: a “1” in both the Team Sets Played and Sets Played fields, and zeroes for the rest of that section. The form requires at least a ‘1’ in those fields in order to save the rest of your stats. Please note that entering this incorrect data this will not affect your athlete’s eligibility.

Nationally Ranked Teams

The list of Nationally Ranked Teams will include:

- All teams that appear on the AVCA Division III Top 25 Coaches Poll at least TWO or more times (not including the DIII Preseason Poll)

There is no minimum or maximum to the quantity of teams that can appear on this list.

Regionally Ranked Teams

The AVCA Regionally Ranked Team List is determined using a combination of the AVCA Nationally Ranked Teams and NCAA NPI Rankings (replaced RAC Regional rankings).

1. All teams that are featured on the 2025 AVCA List of Nationally Ranked Teams, given the guidelines above, will be featured in the list of Regionally-Ranked Teams under their respective region.
2. AND, the top 8 teams per region that are featured on the 2025 NCAA NPI Rankings (as published on November 5, 2025).

No team with a win-loss percentage under .500 can be featured on the AVCA Regionally Ranked Team List. AVCA reserves the right to publish this list with less than the minimum number of 8 teams (as determined by the NCAA NPI Rankings), should the next team(s) ranked have under a .500 win-loss percentage.
