



New York Volleyball Coaches Association Hall of Fame Class of 2026 Jeff Moulton

Jeff grew up in Madrid in upstate New York. He graduated from Madrid-Waddington High School in Section 10. He was a 3-sport athlete in soccer, basketball, and track. He was a 2x inductee into the Madrid-Waddington Hall of Fame for both Soccer and Track.

Jeff received his Bachelor's degree in Physical Education from the State University of New York at Cortland. He was a 2-sport Collegiate athlete in soccer and track. He was a NCAA provisional national qualifier in the Decathlon. Jeff received his first coaching job at SUNY Cortland as an Assistant Track and Field Coach after he graduated. He received his Master's degree in Sports Administration from Montclair State.

Jeff started his teaching and coaching career at Cornwall Central High School in 1999. He has been coaching Volleyball, Basketball and Track for the past 27 years at Cornwall. Coach Moulton has won or been a part of over 50 section titles in 3 sports. He coached the Girls Varsity Basketball to 3 Section 9 titles. He coached 5 NY State Champions in Track and Field in the events of Long Jump, Pole Vault and 100m Hurdles.

In Volleyball, Coach Moulton has led his program to a record of 479 wins 80 losses. The program had a streak of over 6 seasons without losing a match to a section 9 opponent. A Section 9 winning streak of over 103 matches from 2016 - 2023. His program has won 21 consecutive Division Titles, 20 Sectional Titles, 8 Southeast Regional Titles, 8 Final Four Appearances, 3x NYS 4th Place, 4x NYS 3rd Place, and 1x NYS Runner-Up. His teams have won 25 various school tournament titles including Millbrook, Minisink, Hendrick Hudson, John Jay Cross River, Ravena, and Troy.

But his biggest achievement was marrying his best friend and wife, Marietta. She has been coaching by his side for 24 years as the Cornwall Assistant Varsity and Junior Varsity Volleyball. They also started the Cornwall Volleyball Club (CVC). A community volleyball program where every player who wants to try playing volleyball can play. No player has ever been turned away. It has an average of 90 girls each year from grades K – 12. They have coached hundreds of athletes in this program which has led to the success of the Cornwall school program. They both received the Margot Irish Award from NY high school Section 1 for their dedication and service to their community.
